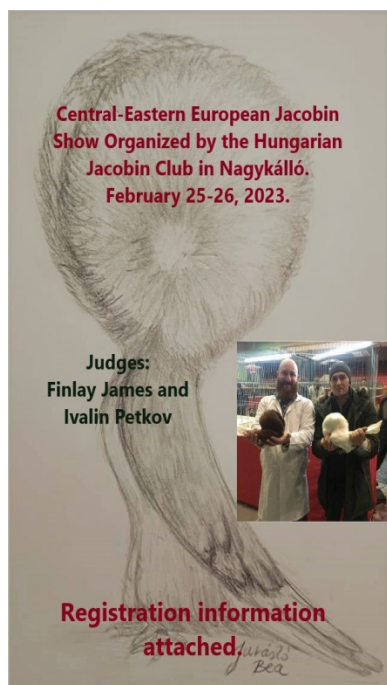

2. Date: February 25-26, 2023

All pigeon Jacobin breeders can participate in the exhibition, whether they are members of the Hungarian Pigeon Jacobin Breeders Breed Club or not.

3. Application deadline: February 12, 2023

We would like to draw everyone's attention to the compliance of the application deadline, as after this point we will be unable to accept any applications.

4. Application fees:

Application fee: 6 Eur/pigeon,

Mandatory catalog and Registration fee: 10 eur

We provide the opportunity for transit/sales cages for those interested in placing their sale pigeons.

The rental fee for the sales cages is: 3 Eur/cage.

A maximum of 2 birds can be placed in one cage and a maximum of 10 cages can be requested as an exhibitor.

The request for sales cages must also be indicated on the application form, and their cost must be transferred along with the application fee.

When transferring, please write the breeder's name as a comment. We can only accept the application with the application fee!

5. The ring number of the birds placed in the cage must be displayed on the cage by the owner. No identifying ring is accepted on the birds, only the EE federation ring is accepted, which can be used from 2017 to 2022.

6. Health conditions: The condition for placing pigeons in the cage is a veterinary certificate no older than 3 days, proving vaccination against paramyxovirus. In the case of foreign exhibitors, it is necessary to have an internationally recognized health certificate in accordance with the laws of their own country. Important! The health certificate does not need to be recorded on the TRACES system-INTRA module! The exhibition cannot be shipped to pigeons from areas affected by high pathogenicity bird influenza outbreak and under restriction! Pigeons brought to the exhibition can undergo veterinary examination before being placed in a cage, and the supplier must show and submit veterinary and vaccination certificates. The organizers will take care of feeding and watering the animals from the time of delivery to release and will also provide health supervision if any of the exhibited pigeons show symptoms of disease, they will be immediately isolated in the available room. In more severe cases, the veterinarian may have to remove them from the exhibition area. However, this is the responsibility of the exhibitor! The organizers will not be liable for the death, damage or exchange of birds, as well as theft and fire damage. The feeder and drinker are the property of the organizing club and must remain in the exhibitor's cage after the exhibition.

7. Bird awards:

The judging will be done by Finlay James (ENG) and Ivalin Petkov (BG).

The birds will be classified into internationally valid color classes, with winners announced by gender and color.

Individuals who have achieved International Winner status will receive a tangible award.

All color class winners of the same sex will be compared to each other, and the most beautiful hen and the most beautiful cock pigeon will be awarded the title of Best International Champion.

Awards will also be given to the best young hen and the best young cock.

Each exhibitor breeder will receive a commemorative plaque!

8. Exhibition Program:

Animal delivery and placement in cages: February 24, 15:00-18:00 (3:00-6:00 pm)

Animal judging: February 25, 8:00 am

Results announced: February 26, 10:00 am

Animals release: February 26, 11:00 am

Visitors can see the exhibition on:

Saturday from 9:00-17:00 and on Sunday from 9:00-11:00 am.

By registering for the exhibition, each participant acknowledges and accepts the terms of the entry and the rules of the exhibition. In cases not covered by this regulation, the exhibition committee will take necessary measures to ensure the smooth operation of the exhibition.

BLACK, RED, YELLOW, BLUE, SILVER, SPLASH (ALL COLORS), ASH RED, ASH YELLOW AND WHITE.

(AOC): KITE, DUN, ALMOND, BROWN, KHAKI, INDIGO, ANDALUSIAN, MILKY (POWDER), GRIZZLE, OPAL VARIATIONS.
